§ 160.50(2)(b) - No Contact Order (NCO)

### **Rights of Victims for No Contact Orders (NCO)**

§ 160.50(2)(b) - No Contact Order (NCO) - A No Contact Order (NCO) is a court order that prohibits a perpetrator from contacting a victim. The NCO is issued by the court after a finding of domestic violence. The NCO is enforceable for a period of 12 months, unless the court orders otherwise. The NCO prohibits the perpetrator from contacting the victim in any manner, including in person, by telephone, by mail, by electronic communication, or by any other means. The NCO also prohibits the perpetrator from coming within a certain distance of the victim's residence, workplace, or school. The NCO is enforceable by the police. If the perpetrator violates the NCO, the perpetrator may be arrested and charged with a crime. The NCO is a civil order, but it is enforceable by the police. **Important Definitions**

**Fire:** Any uncontrolled fire that is not extinguished within a reasonable period.

**Cause of Fire:** The primary reason for the occurrence of a fire, such as a faulty electrical system, a blocked fire exit, or a blocked fire alarm.

**Fire Drill:** A planned evacuation exercise for fire safety.

**Fire-Related Injury:** Any person who is injured as a result of a fire, including those who are injured by smoke, heat, or fire.

**Fire-Related Death:** Any person who dies as a result of a fire (1) Immediately or (2) During the course of hospitalization as a result of the fire.

**Fire Safety System:** Any system designed to detect, alarm, or extinguish fires, such as smoke detectors, fire extinguishers, fire doors, and fire alarms.

**Value of Property Damage:** The total value of property damaged as a result of a fire, including the value of the property and the cost of repairs.
